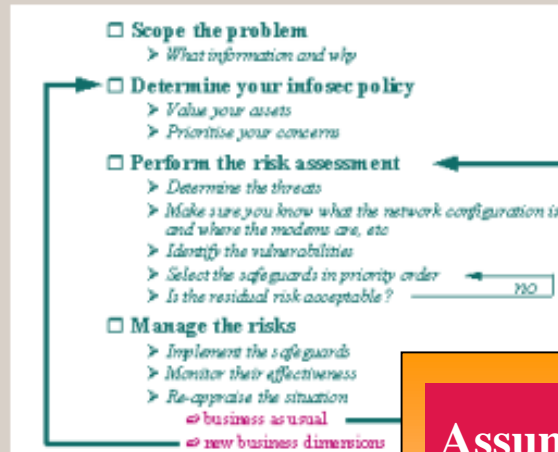
What is it?

Check in place & is it effective?

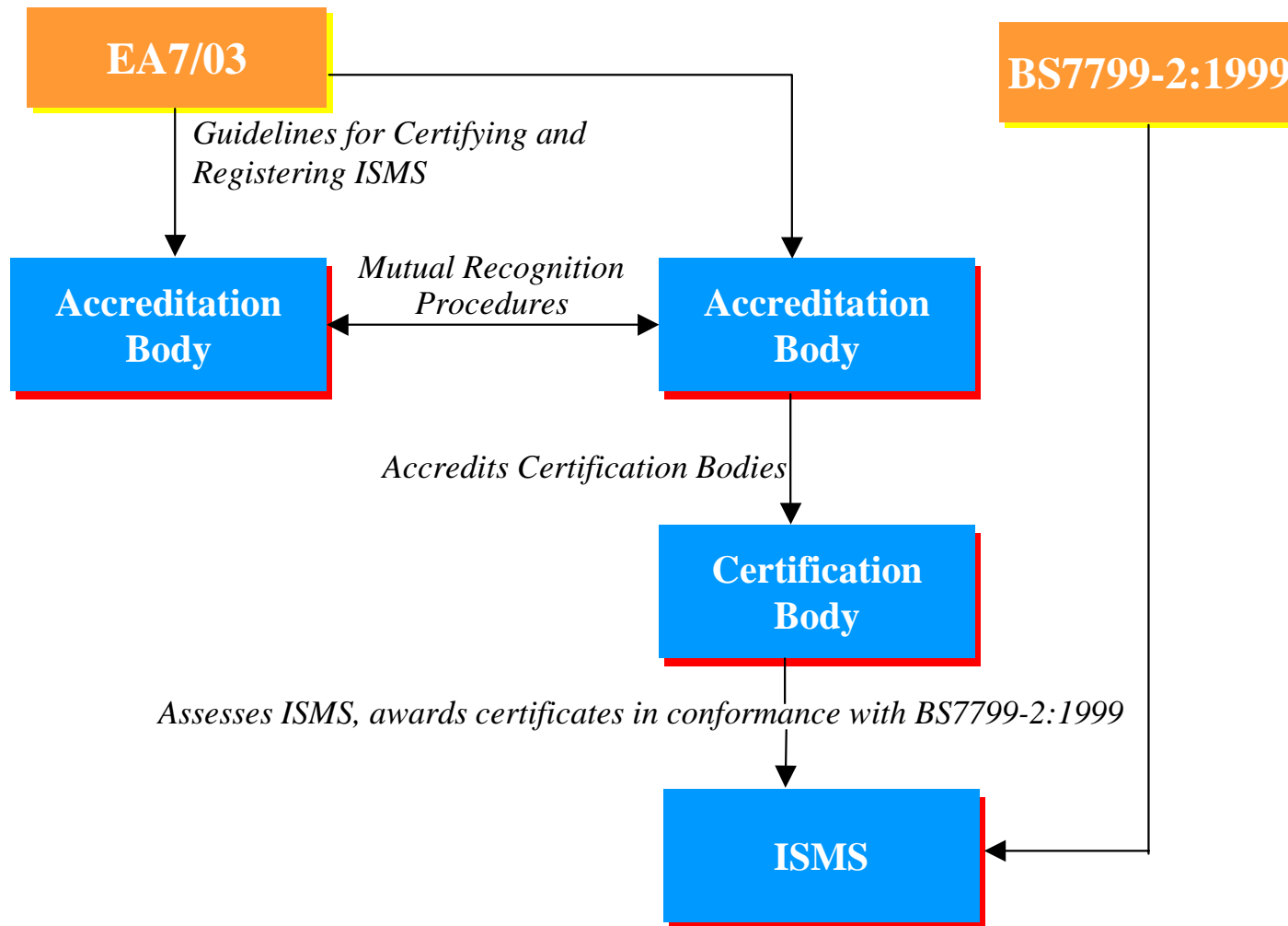

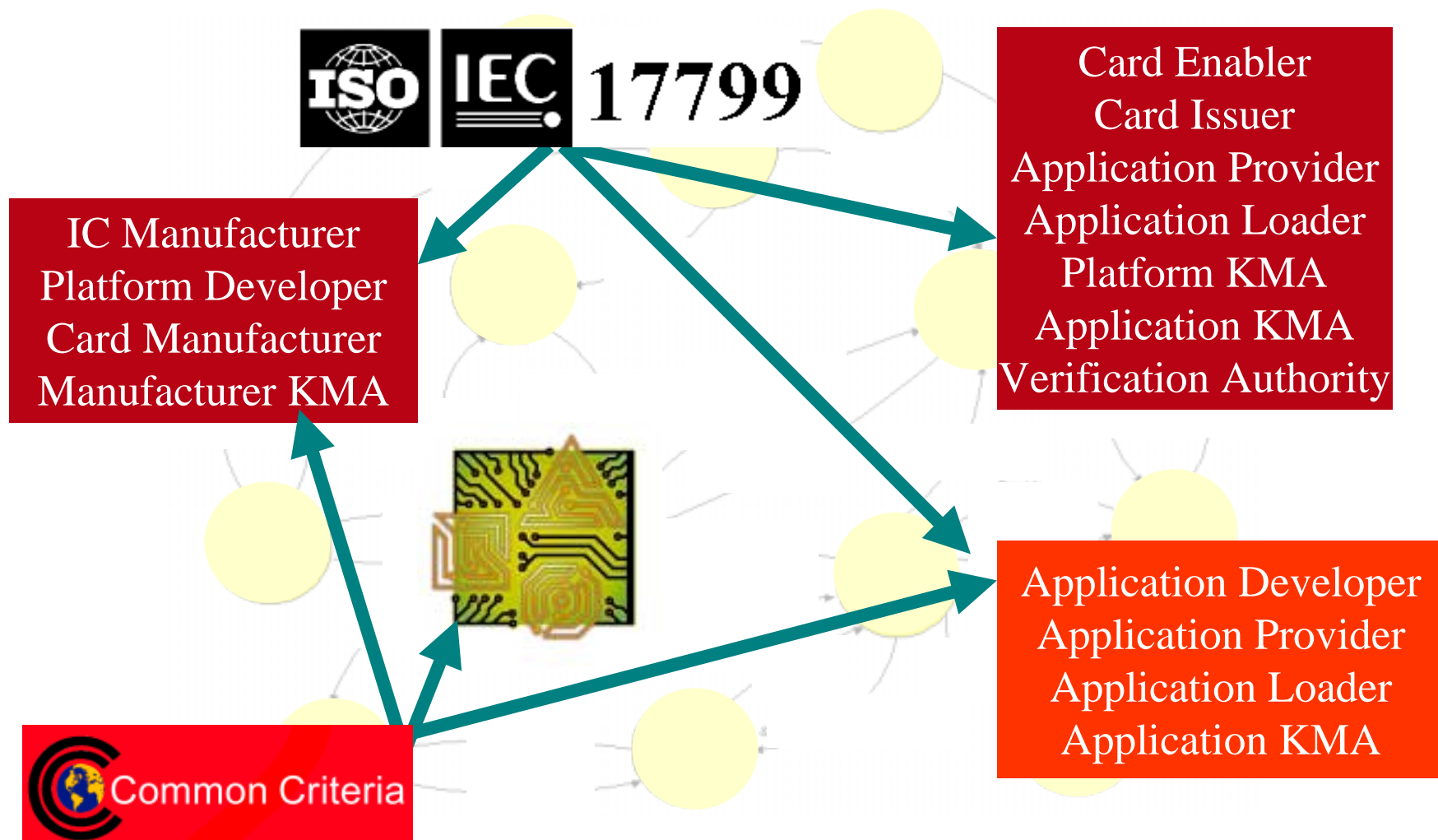
MRA and Certification
